

#### Photomedicine

She is a fellow within the American Academy of Medical Acupuncture (AAMA) and has served on the American Board of Medical Acupuncture and the AAMA Board of Directors.

*Interactive Medical Acupuncture Anatomy,* Dr. Robinson's landmark neuroanatomic atlas, represents the culmination of fifteen years of study into the structure-function relationships of acupuncture points and their supporting evidence.

*Canine Medical Massage,* which Dr. Robinson co-authored with massage therapist Shelley Sheets, combines osteopathic medical principles with Swedish massage techniques to produce the first canine medical massage book, also the companion text for our veterinary medical massage and myofascial palpation course.
